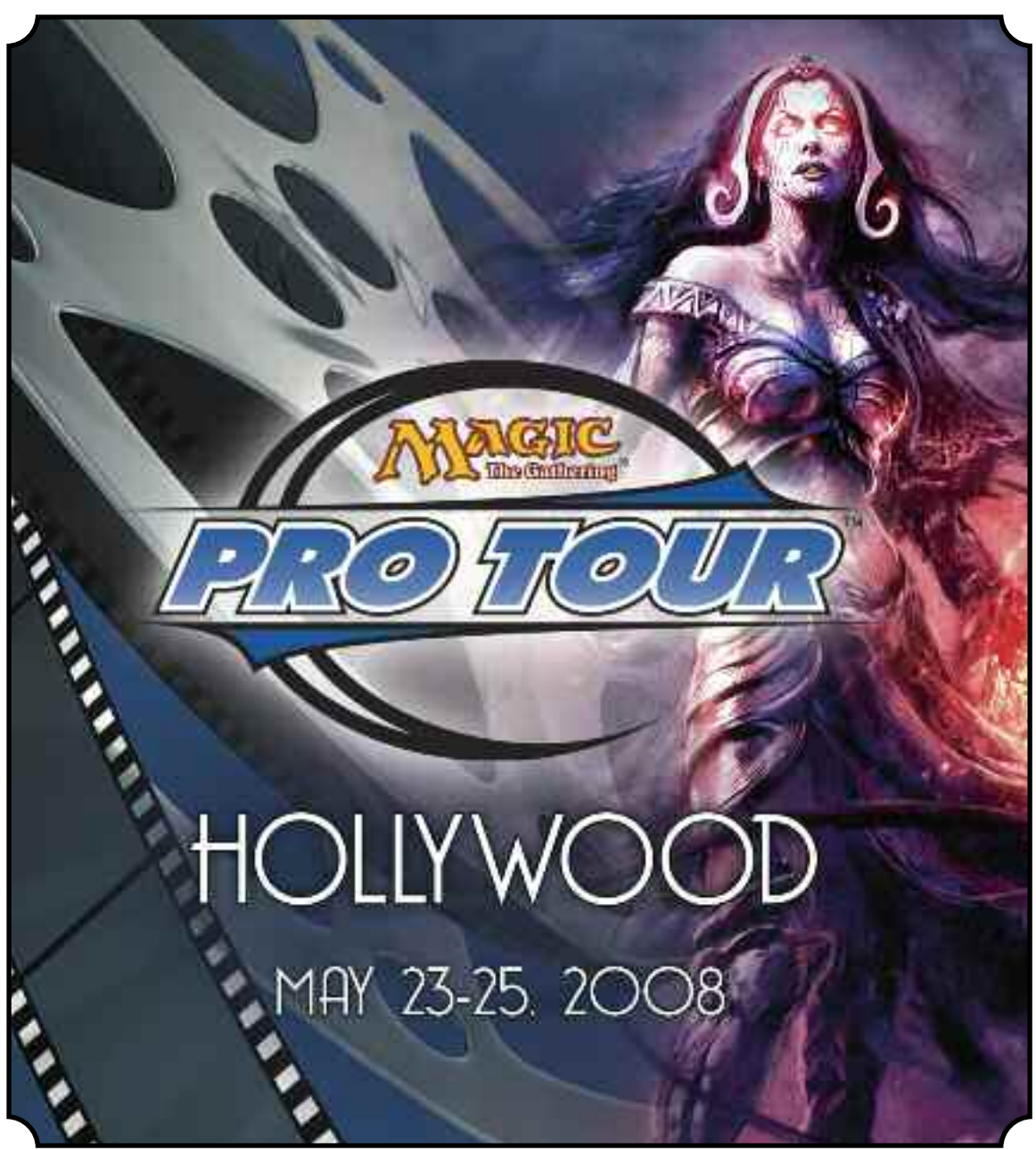

How to qualify for a Pro Tour?

The Pro Tour is a dream for many Magic players. The tournament is restricted to invited players and allows the best Magic players on the planet to battle for the coveted title of "Pro Tour Champion". If you too would like to be part of this VIP club, there are several different ways to qualify.

Grand Prix
These international tournaments are open to everyone and give no less than sixteen invitations to the Pro Tour. It's the most "professional" tournament which is open to all players. With a festive atmosphere and great locations GP's are a great way to play the game and see the world while you mingle with both professional and amateur players. It mingles with both professionals and amateurs.



is open to any DCI member who earned a Pro Point in the previous or current season. To join, complete a Consent and Waiver Agreement for the tournament where you earned the Pro Point (ask your TO). All Pro Points earned in a season constitute your Player of the Year standing and your level in the Pro Club.

- Level 3: 15 points
- Level 4: 20 points
- Level 5: 25 points
- Level 6: 30 points
- Level 7: 40 points
- Level 8: 50 points

When you reach Level 3 of the Pro Club, you get 2 byes at all GP's, an invite to your National Championships, and an invite to one Pro Tour or Worlds (your choice)! And the benefits just get better as you go up!

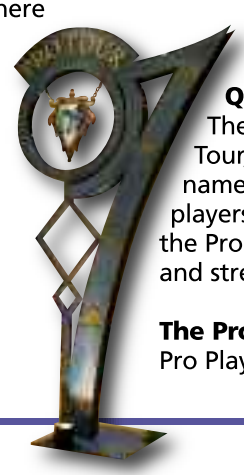
Pro Tour Qualifier tournaments (PTQ)

For each Pro Tour there will be a series of qualifier events spread throughout the world. These events offer invitations to the Pro Tour where you meet players of all levels and will doubtless have a great time.

Last Chance Qualifier

The day before each Pro Tour, a "last chance" tournament rewards four lucky players with an invitation to the Pro Tour. Over-tiredness and stress should be expected!
